



## **West Yorkshire Housing Partnership CEO Meeting – 16 March 2022** **Summary of Discussions for External Publication**

### **Background**

This document summarises the discussions at the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership on 16 March 2022. It will be published for external partners and stakeholders to keep up to date with the work of the Partnership.

### **Meeting summary**

The meeting included the following discussions:

- Creating great places to live – Presentation from Amir Hussain, Deputy Chair of the West Yorkshire Combined Authority Place, Regeneration and Housing Committee.
- Awayday – A positive session with workstream leads at the awayday setting the ambitions for the Partnership for 2022.
- Climate emergency – Members agreed to provide funding for several projects to support the decarbonisation of residential properties in West Yorkshire, including working with the West Yorkshire Combined Authority.
- Investment and regeneration – How best practice on damp and mould will be shared and progress against the Mayor’s target of 5,000 new affordable homes. Members agreed to share data with the West Yorkshire Combined Authority to track progress on development.
- Inclusive growth – How members can make best use of future funding opportunities for the benefit of our communities, agreeing to explore this further.
- Health and housing – Report from John Ebo, Assistant Director, Improving Population Health Programme at the West Yorkshire Health and Care Partnership.
- Homelessness – How members could contribute to the national priority of ending rough sleeping.
