



West Yorkshire Housing Partnership CEO Meeting – 24 January 2024

Summary of Discussions for External Publication

Background

This document summarises the discussions at the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership meeting on 24 January 2024. It will be published for external partners and stakeholders to keep up to date with the work of the Partnership.

Meeting summary

The meeting included the following discussions:

- West Yorkshire Fair Work Charter – Members discussed the launch of the Mayor’s Charter. It was agreed to have further discussions with the Combined Authority regarding members signing up to the Charter.
- Health, Housing and Homelessness – Members discussed the approach to dementia ready housing criteria and how this could be incorporated into their development standards. There was also a discussion about support for joint work with the University of Huddersfield.
- Investment and Regeneration – Information was provided about work on affordability and investment pressures for older homes.
- Climate Emergency – An update was given on the progress of the solar PV and battery project, with work expected to begin in the Spring.
- West Yorkshire Combined Authority – An update was given on their work including the positive outcome of the Strategic Place Partnership (SPP) Developer Forum.
- The Mayor of West Yorkshire, Tracy Brabin, attended and gave an update of her plans and areas of focus.
