



West Yorkshire Housing Partnership CEO Meeting – 25 May 2023 **Summary of Discussions for External Publication**

Background

This document summarises the discussions at the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership meeting on 25 May 2023. It will be published for external partners and stakeholders to keep up to date with the work of the Partnership.

Meeting summary

The meeting included the following discussions:

- Meeting with the West Yorkshire Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime, Alison Lowe – Members had a positive meeting with the Deputy Mayor, discussing her priorities and the work of the West Yorkshire Housing Partnership
- Membership – The West Yorkshire Housing Partnership welcomed the Guinness Partnership as a new member.
- Damp, mould and condensation training – Members agreed a collaborative approach to further improve the knowledge of colleagues.
- West Yorkshire Combined Authority – The Combined Authority gave an update on its work, including the Strategic Place Partnership with Homes England.
- Climate emergency – An update was provided on the collaborative approaches being taken, including around the successful bid for Wave 2 of the Social Housing Decarbonisation Fund.
- Inclusive growth – Members are working collaboratively to identify opportunities for inclusive growth for social housing residents, collating information about members' current approaches.
- Health, housing and homelessness – Members have agreed an approach to Dementia Champions within their organisations and work is ongoing looking at dementia ready housing.
